Webinar on ‘Transition in Property Rights from Medieval to Modern India’

(Research Methodology)

- To give participants an insight over the changes in property rights from medieval period to the modern era.
- To discuss and highlight the various changes in Intellectual Property Rights from Medieval to Modern India.

The P.G. Department of History organized a webinar on “Transition in Property Rights from Medieval to Modern India” on 18th September 2020. The resource persons of the webinar were Dr. Veena Sachdeva (Punjab University Chandigarh), Dr. Radha Sharma (GNDU Amritsar), and Dr. Harish Sharma (GNDU Amritsar). The faculty members from various institutions along with the students and faculty of the College took active participation in the webinar and made it great success.

Mr. Amit Kumar, Asst. Prof., P.G. Department of History, SSM College, Dinanagar inaugurated the webinar and outlined the theme of the webinar. After that Principal Dr. R. K. Tuli, welcomed the dignitaries and introduced them with the participants.

Dr. Veena Sachdeva (Former President of Department of History, Punjab University Chandigarh) started her discourse by discussing about the role of intermediary Zamindars housed to collect land Revenue from the Primary Zamindars (cultivators) and gave it to the

Government. Early medieval Indian economy, polity, society, and religion became more and more linked and depended on the land and its resources. Zamindars were serving the state as an intermediary so they get reward for that from the government in the form of land and they get tax exemption by the government for their own land. She discussed her course with the help of a Power point presentation. She elaborated Doaba area of Punjab and the Zamindari system and system of land revenue collection. **Dr. Radha Sharma** (Former Head, Department of History and Dean Faculty of Arts and social Sciences, GNDU Amritsar) discussed the Transition in Property Rights from early 19th century to modern times and also about the state of Punjab in early 19th Century. She also elaborated her topic through the power point presentation. **Dr. Harish Sharma** (Former Head, Department of History and Public Relation Officer GNDU Amritsar) discussed about the landed property customs and Women Rights in the colonial Punjab.

In the end of the Webinar Asst. Prof Amit Kumar, thanked the Resource Persons and participants for making the webinars a great success.

Outcomes:-

- Participants identified the difference between the intellectual property rights in ancient time and in modern era
- Participants got to know about the influence of British colonial rule on property rights in India and how it shaped the modern property laws.


