During the last 44 years, the seed sowed by early Founders of the college has grown into a full fledged tree to take the legitimate pride in rendering **meritorious services** in this **Rural, Backward and Border Belt Area** by carving a niche for itself in the educational spheres. Endeavoring to be one of the **Best and Speedy** growing institutions, the college has been expanding its wings in all fields by **adhering to moral values as its strength.**

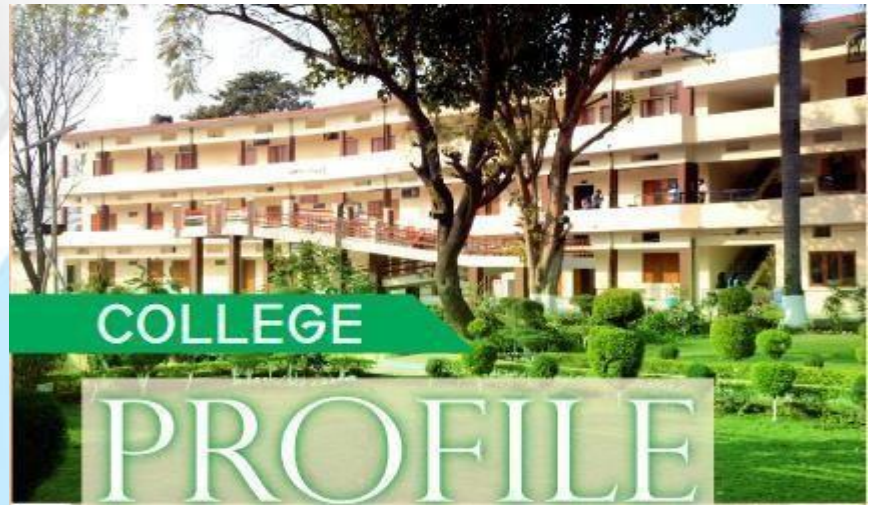
The total **strength of the** college is increasing by **leaps and bounds** and it has crossed the **Proud figure** of 3000. The college has a dedicated faculty of **95 members** of teaching and **50 members** of non-teaching staff. All the teachers are well qualified, meritorious and having Ph.d, M.Phil, M.Tech, B.Tech degrees and other post graduates are net qualified. The institution has to its credit traditional courses in the field of **Humanities, Commerce, Science (Both Medical and Non-Medical)** along with B.Sc (Internet & Mobile Technology), **BCA, BBA, B.Com**

(Pass Course & Honors), B.Lib & P.G. courses in Hindi, Punjabi, History, Economics, M.Sc (Mathematics, Computer Science, Information Technology, Physics, Fashion Designing M.Com, Post Graduate Diplomas, PGDCA, Diploma in Library Science, Diploma in Computer Applications).

The college is progressing day by day, with its already existing, well designed and splendid building but the enhancement of new and huge infrastructure has become the regular feature of the college.

- The college has **60 classrooms** and **separate blocks for Arts, Science, Commerce and Computer Science Departments**, All the Departments have been fitted with **Smart Boards and LCD projectors**.
- The college has **well equipped** and **Ultra-tech** labs for Science subjects at least two for each **subject Chemistry, Botany and Zoology and four labs for Physics**. The college has also six **computer labs** at present and we have increased its number in order to fulfill the needs of the increasing strength of students for practicals. Each lab is provided with **Fastest Internet Access** both for **teachers and students**.
- **Home Science** and **Psychology Labs** are equipped with latest infrastructure.
- The college has **Hi-tech Seminar Hall, spacious Auditorium, Open Air Theatre, Gymnasium Hall and Multimedia labs** with latest gadgets.
- Comfortable infrastructure has been provided to the staff with two staff rooms and separate offices for different Departments.
- **An Indoor Stadium** is a new feature added to the campus of SSM providing congenial environment for Indoor Games.
- **All Weather Campus** is another catchy feature of the college campus.

- Other basic necessities like Water coolers, Water Purifiers are provided to the students.
- We have also a **College Dispensary** for the routine check-up of the students, **College Canteen** with separate arrangements for students and staff, **Separate Hostels** for boys and girls and **Students' Centre** for various rehearsals.
- The College has also rebuilt **IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)** for the meetings of the members of IQAC.
- **Library** which is called the heart of an institution is fully computerized and has been converted into open shelf library. It also has the facility of **Book Bank** for poor and needy students.
- The college also has **Women Study Centre** befitted with the cut outs of Great Women for the inspiration of girl students.
- For all round growth of students the college has **NCC, NSS Units, Girls Welfare Society, Youth Welfare Department, Counseling and Guidance Cell, Placement Cell** and Fleet of Buses for students' conveyance.

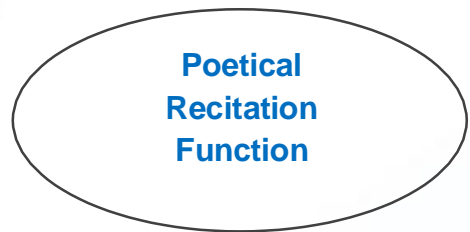

Besides this The Youth Welfare Department of the College organized as well as participated in a number of activities that ensure the All Round Development of the Youth.

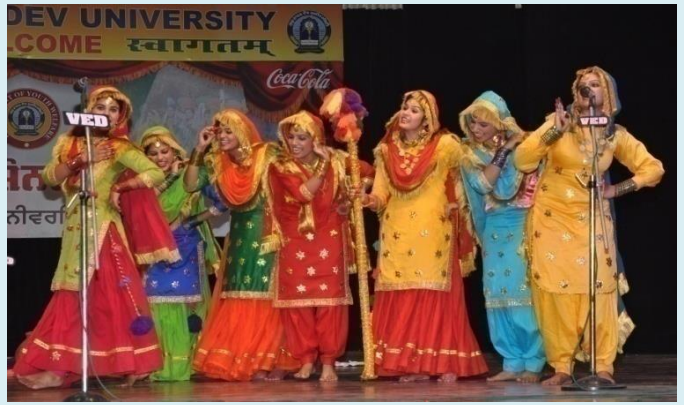
