Scholarship / Concession Policy

**Financial Assistance to Students
Through
Scholarships, Freeships and Concessions**



SSM College always work for financially weaker students by offering them strong financial support. In order to do that no student is denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy, scholarships are provided by the institution, Government and non-government bodies and philanthropists. Scholarships are given to students on need basis and also to meritorious students. The procedure of grant of scholarship by the management is clearly defined in the scholarship policy of the institution.

Eligibility:

- The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- Have received an unconditional admission offer from the College.
- Have maintained the minimum attendance as specified by the College rules and regulations.
- Candidate must not be a beneficiary of any other scholarship award provided by any party.

Procedure:

- The students who are intending to avail this facility have to submit their application in a prescribed format to their respective head of the department.
- The applications can be collected from the College Library.
- The head of the department based on the applicant's academic performance and the economic background scrutinize the application and the same is discussed with the concerned authority.
- The recommendation of the faculty council is forwarded to the Principal by the Head of the Department.

Beneficiaries:

- Financially weaker students on the basis of their minority status.
- Poor and Needy students with a strong will to study further.
- Fee concession to single girl child.
- Fee concession to needy university merit holders.
- Alumni sponsored scholarships to deserving students.

- Full fee waivers will be provided to outstanding sports performers along with free mess facility as well as free hostel facility.
- Special scholarship of Rs. 11, 00/- to those students who opt Sanskrit as an elective subject.
- Special concession to girl students.
- Fee concession to the parentless child.
