Aims and Objectives:

To formulate and adhere to specific quality benchmarks for research to meet the global/international standards.

To conduct a quality review (SWOC Analysis) or internal evaluation of the research papers and suggests Scopus Indexed, Web of Sciences (WOS), or UGC-CARE recognized journals for appropriate publications.

Our Guidelines for Research:

It's mandatory for all faculty members & research scholars to follow these guidelines:

- Before submitting the soft copy of their final research, the research paper should be reviewed appropriately by the RDC.
- All research articles should be screened for plagiarism using plagiarism detection software or through appropriate plagiarism checking tools.
- Each faculty member must provide an undertaking stating that the
 research was done by them, that it is their original work, and that there is
 no plagiarism in the paper.
- Rewriting another person's writing by altering part of the words or their sequence without properly citing the author is strictly prohibited.
- Employing concepts that were originally someone else's without crediting them is also counted as illegal step.
- Copying and pasting the internet content is also not allowed.
- Any violation shall be brought to the attention of the Principal/Convener
 of RDC for the necessary disciplinary action, as well as the ethical
 committee established by RAC (Research Advisory Committee).

The RDC shall investigate all instances of plagiarism and advise the most appropriate course of action to take against the offender.

Similarity %	Action
Up to 10%	A minor similarity so paper will be accepted.
10-25 %	Shall be asked to review the paper again and reduce the similarity.
More than 25%	The paper will be rejected.
