1. Opening remarks by the Hon'ble Principal Dr. R.K. Tuli, Chairman IQAC and welcome to the members of IQAC

3. Report of the follow up action on the decisions taken by the IQAC in its meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2019:

- 9. To plan about the organization of major functions: The Chairperson IQAC, informed the other members about the major events of the college like Annual Convocation, Annual Sports Meet, Poetical Recitation Competition and Annual Prize Distribution Function. He made heads for the different events and assigned the task to the faculty members.
- 10. To discuss any other item with the permission of chair: The Coordinator IQAC, Dr. Rajan Kumar discussed about the up gradation of the infrastructure of the college. He expressed the need to add new furniture in classrooms. The committee members approved the decision.
